

Kedarnath & Badrinath Yatra – 6 Days (From Haridwar)

Day 1: Haridwar → Guptkashi (210 km / 8–9 hrs)

- Detailed Highlights:
- Morning pickup from Haridwar and begin journey to Guptkashi.
- Enjoy picturesque views of rivers and mountains en route.
- Visit confluences like Devprayag and Rudraprayag on the way.
- Evening arrival at Guptkashi; hotel check-in and rest.

Day 2: Guptkashi → Sonprayag → Kedarnath (17 km trek / 6 hrs)

- Detailed Highlights:
- Early departure to Sonprayag; shuttle to Gaurikund.
- Start 17 km trek to Kedarnath (pony/palanquin available at own cost).
- Reach Kedarnath by afternoon; attend evening aarti at the temple.
- Stay overnight in camps/tents near the temple (own arrangement or by package).

Day 3: Kedarnath → Guptkashi

- Detailed Highlights:
- Early morning darshan at Kedarnath Temple.
- Begin return trek to Gaurikund; shuttle back to Sonprayag.
- Drive to Guptkashi and rest for the night at the hotel.

Day 4: Guptkashi → Badrinath (190 km / 7–8 hrs)

- Detailed Highlights:
- Drive to Badrinath via Joshimath and Chamoli.
- En route admire stunning Himalayan scenery and valleys.
- Evening arrival in Badrinath; visit Tapt Kund and attend aarti.
- Hotel check-in and overnight stay.

Day 5: Badrinath Sightseeing → Pipalkoti (80 km / 3 hrs)

- Detailed Highlights:
- Early morning darshan of Lord Badrivishal at Badrinath Temple.
- Visit Brahma Kapal, Mana Village, Vyas Gufa, Bhim Pul, and Saraswati River.

- Drive to Pipalkoti by evening; check-in and rest at hotel.

Day 6: Pipalkoti → Rishikesh → Haridwar (240 km / 6–7 hrs)

- Detailed Highlights:
- Post-breakfast journey to Rishikesh via Devprayag.
- Visit Ram Jhula and Laxman Jhula and enjoy Ganga Aarti if time permits.
- Evening arrival in Haridwar; tour concludes with blessings and memories.
